In 2020, we moved downtown to a 2,500 square feet premises on the ground floor of 555 Howe Street, Vancouver. Our new location is a busy area with hotels, retail centres and restaurants frequented by tourists. We will continue to promote arts through exhibitions and events, and concentrate on the sale of paintings and art pieces of local artists, to create a win-win situation for our artists and their collectors. With the benefit of our past experience in helping international auction houses to acquire collectable paintings and items for their seasonal auctions, we will experiment on the sale and consignment of Oriental and Western collectable pieces at our gallery, while continuing to cooperate with these auction houses to advance their services and to address to the needs of local collectors and customers.

BOTTRILL Alice

Alice BOTTRILL, an inspiring artist and instructor, is a member of the Federation of Canadian Artists, a member of NSAG, NV Arts and the International Watercolor Society of Canada. She is the BC Representative for IWS Canada. Her paintings cover a wide range of subject matters with her expressive brush strokes infused with translucent hues and moods, suggesting passionate backstories and memorable moments.

Alice's artworks have been accepted into numerous shows including International Art Gallery, FCA gallery, NSAG Art shows, the Cityscape gallery, Brush Stoke gallery and her artworks are also represented by Diana Hall Gallery in Sweden. Her painting have gained local and international acclaim and have been selected into International Watercolour exhibitions in more than 12 countries including Italy, China, Portugal, Malaysia, Pakistan, Hungary, Poland, Ukraine, Romania, Switzerland, India ... and won awards in local gallery and International exhibitions. In 2018, Alice was invited by the International Watercolor Society of Hungary to perform a live demonstration at IWS exhibition in Budapest and in 2019, she was invited for another live demonstration showing her skills as an accomplished Canadian artist at the IWS exhibition in Gdansk, Poland. Alice's artworks are well appreciated by local and international collectors, including the International Watercolor Society of Hungary and Poland.

To Alice, the mastery of watercolor is a lifetime pursuit, although it can't be a fixed destination, in the meantime, she is focusing on sharpening her skills and strengthening her mental fortitude to grow stronger as an artist. Currently she paints and teaches watercolour workshop in her studio in North Vancouver and also offers free watercolor lessons for children on behalf of IWS Canada in a hope to spread the love of watercolor to the next generation.

CHAN Tinyan 陳田恩

Tinyan studied in the Canton Academy of Fine Arts in Guangzhou, China and the prestigious L' Ecole Nationale Superieure des Beaux-Arts in Paris, France. In 1968, Tinyan immigrated to Canada to start his career as a professional artist.

Since the early 1970's, Tinyan has held more than one hundred one-man shows in many of the major cities of North America. He made his entrance into the mainstream Canadian art society in the late 1970's by becoming a member of the Federation of Canadian Artists (F.C.A). In 1983, he was the first Chinese artist to be selected by the F.C.A as a Senior Member of the association, thus being granted the title of S.F.C.A. Tinyan won several International Awards and Medals. The extent of his achievements were acknowledged in the year 2011 when he was selected by the F.C.A to be the recipient of the "Lifetime Achievement Award". This award was presented in recognition of his outstanding contribution to the world of art. Tinyan was the first Asian to receive such a high honour and accomplishment in the 70 years history of the Federation's establishment since 1941.

CHAUNG Ivy 張靄維

Member of the Oil Painters of America Member of the California Artist Club Member of the Federation of Canadian Artists

Ivy graduated from the Guangzhou Academy of Fine Arts High School in 1958. After graduation from the Guangzhou Academy of Oil Painting Department from 1962, she started her teaching career at the Academy,

and also served as an editor of the "Guangdong Illustrated" and "Guangdong People's House". After 1979 she has lived in Hong Kong, Taiwan, the United States and finally settled down in Canada. She has been engaging in oil painting and teaching till now. She has over twenty solo exhibitions and eight publications of art albums. She has done portrait for many world famous politicians and celebrities, including former president of Indonesian President SUHARTO couples, former Vice President of Taiwan HSIEH Tung-Min, former Chief of National Defense HAU Pei-Tsun, Chairman of World Media Group WANG Shifu, influential Taiwan entrepreneur WANG Yung Ching couples, former Dean of Taipei Veterans General Hospital PENG Fang-Gu couples, former Miss Hong Kong Loretta CHU and many others. Ivy was Invited by the Tianjin People's Fine Arts Publishing House to publish "Overseas Chinese Painters - Ivy CHUANG" in 2007, and "Overseas Chinese Oil Painting Selection" in 2011. Ivy has held Portrait Painting Exhibition and raised funds for BC Childrens Hospital in 2010. Ivy's oil painting portrait of Prime Minister Stephen HARPER was also collected by the Prime Minister's Office; being the first Canadian Chinese Artist to have a portrait painting collected by the Prime Minister.

CHUI Paul 徐榕生

CHUI Yung Sang (Paul) was born in 1933. Student of Master LAM Chin Shek and learned Chinese calligraphy and painting when he was in primary school. Later, he studied western painting and art design. He held positions in the Art Departments at three television stations in Hong Kong. "Enjoy Yourself Tonight" was the longest running vaudeville in

Television Broadcast (TVB) in Hong Kong. The title of the show was written in Chinese calligraphy by CHUI. In Hong Kong 1958, he held his first solo painting exhibition in St. John's Cathedral. Later, he joined the Circle Art Group and became quite active in the local art circle. In 1973, CHUI immigrated to Canada. In 1975, he held his first painting exhibition at the Bau-Xi Art Gallery in Vancouver. In 1986, he was placed second in the Phillippe Charriol Foundation Modern Painting Competition Exhibition (Hong Kong and Paris). He was the winner of the Special Award at Western Paintings Category of the 1st Canada Chinese Arts Bridge Art Competition 2014, a member of the Vancouver Chinese Artist Association and one of the four selected Hong Kong artists participated in the "Pacific Crossings" Exhibition in Vancouver Art Gallery 2017.

DUAN Zheng Zhong 段震中

DUAN Zhen Zhong was born in 1944 in Anhui, China. He graduated from the Central Academy of Arts and Design in year 1969, majored in Decorative Arts and Architecture. After graduation he had been working for years as Senior Art Director with the Beijing Film Studio.

DUAN Zhen-Zhong has also been a member of the Chinese Association of Movie Artists, a member of the Chinese Academy of Movie

Artists and a member of the Oriental Art Association, where he was Director of the Research Division for Qi Baishi Art Academy.

DUAN Zhen Zhong's art design had appeared in many significant movie and television productions, and had received many awards for his contribution to the Chinese movie industry. In year 1989, his art production at movie "Waiting for Daybreak" was nominated to enter the "Golden Rooster" Award.

DUAN migrated to the United States in year 1995. He is Full Member of the American Oil Painting Association and the Brown County Art Guild in Nashville IN, and also honorary professor of South China University of Technology of mainland China.

DUAN Zhen Zhong is an accomplished watercolor and oil painter, specialized in landscape and architectures. His work has been exhibited internationally, in Beijing, Hong Kong, Europe and the United States; and have received prizes and awards on many occasions. His painting exhibits detailed attention to the combination of color; shading of black, white, grey; warm and cold; processing of dots and lines; and control of rhythm. Whether the image being smoke ascending from a stone house in a mountain village in northern China; or fishing boats underneath the stone bridge at the water town of Jiangnan; or the wild ducks and falling leaves at Central Park of New York; or the dimming lights along the streets in Paris; stone pavement and steps leading to a church or awooden hut; all exhibited strong sentiments towards where he is. The feeling is subtle, elegant and poetic.

His oil paintings have also been displayed and sold by prestigious and highly respected art auction houses like Sotheby's and Christie's.

CHEN Gao 陳高

Gao CHEN was born in Jiangsu of China in 1946 and grew up in Shanghai, China. He started his art career as an art designer at Shanghai Museum of Arts And Crafts. CHEN immigrated to Vancouver, Canada in 1989 and has since been working as a freelance painter. His past exhibitions includes: September 2009 «Solo exhibition» Basic inquiry studios & Gallery Vancouver; May 2015 «Joint exhibition» Omega Gallery Vancouver. He also held

exhibitions for ArtRich in 2015 and 2019 at Richmond Art Gallery in Richmond, «The Charm of Gardens» at Dr.Sun Yat-Sen Classical Chinese Garden and the 2019 Vancouver Arts Carnival "Splendour of Canada" Paintings Exhibition in Vancouver.

Gao CHEN joined the Vancouver Painters Association in 1990 and has been an artist commissioned by Vancouver Artland Holdings Ltd. to paint 30 landscape paintings for its flagship Downtown apartment building in 1991. CHEN is known for his European classical painting style and later switched to the impressionist style. His paintings consist primarily of portraits and landscapes.

CHEN's paintings are sincere and true to life, shows his poetic touch and his pursuit of an ideal life. The simplicity and brevity in his oil painting, the use of light and bright contrasting colors have made his paintings very popular. During CHEN's 26 years of painting career in Canada, he has created modern paintings that have received broad acclaim both in Canada and China. The "Splendour of Canada" exhibition featured Gao CHEN's landscape painting in the theme of an art gallery. It vividly draws the various visitors in different ages, clothing, gestures and facial expression to reflect their true feelings while attending the exhibition. This painting is appealing as it allows viewers to imagine themselves enjoying the exhibition in the art gallery.

GUO Hangjian 郭杭建

Hang-Jian GUO, a famous Chinese painter, was born in 1957 in Hangzhou, Zhejiang Province, China. He studied at the Hangzhou Arts School and Zhejiang Academy of Fine Arts. He currently serves as a professor of Arts Academy in Hangzhou University, and an art journal editor.

Since 1976, his artworks have participated in various domestic and international art exhibitions. He has won more than 90 awards and created more than 400 art pieces. He had eight personal exhibitions, donated more than 80 pieces of artworks to National Museum of China. He has published many articles and books including "Guo Hang-Jian Paintings" and "Chinese Folk Crafts Album". He is the winner of the Silver Award of the Chinese Painting Category at the 1st Canada Chinese Arts Bridge Art Competition 2014.

KAMIKURA Joyce Harumi

Joyce Harumi KAMIKURA was one of the first Canadians to be bestowed Signature Member of the National Watercolor Society (NWS - U.S.A.).

She was also one of the first women to be given the top ranking in the Federation of Canadian Artists as a Senior Signature Member (SFCA).

Exhibitions of her works in national and international juried exhibitions have earned her many articles internationally. Some of these include the books, Painting Composition (US), Painting Color (US), Abstract in Watercolor (US), Best of Watercolor (US), Looking In, Lookingout (Canada); the magazines, American Artists (US), Art Impressions (Canada), Asahi Graph (Japan), Watercolour Gazette (Canada); International Artists (Australia); Viewpoint, (Canada) and the dailies, Vancouver Sun (Canada), and Times Colonist (Canada).

Joyce was born in Steveston, B.C., spent her first 4 years in the internment camp, Lemon Creek, B.C., then in Japan for 9 years. Her return to Canada took her to Montreal for 2 years then back to Richmond. Years after obtaining her Bachelor of Commerce and Business Administration Degree from the University of B.C., she studied art at Kwantlen and Langara colleges.

KHAN Shameen

With an Architectural career spanning three continents, watercolor has always been an important medium in the work of Shameem KHAN, to convey an initial representation of any design project. The fluidity and transparency of watercolors makes it an ideal choice to loosely represent the vision and feasibility of the design. With the onset of digital technology and computer-generated

imagery, the role of water-colors took a back seat for a while and was shelved as an occasional weekend dabble.

Taking part and winning an award in a local Nanaimo art festival, rekindled Shameem's desire to immerse himself into the unpredictable and wonderful ways of watercolor once again and has been painting on a regular basis since. With a few more art shows and awards under his belt, watercolor has become Shameem's medium of choice to express his art to his growing and appreciative audiences.

Shameem derives inspiration from architectural styles and relationships of shapes and forms to each other and the impact to the light and atmospheric mood that can be expressed into a painting style unique to the artist. The subject matter of the artwork has a wide range of urban and rural settings from almost every region of the globe, however shape and form, light and mood with a unifying color family are a common thread in all the artworks. Shameem KHAN has regular exhibited his watercolors in the Lower Mainland and Vancouver Island in British Columbia, Canada, and is a winner of numerous awards for his works.

KOSTIC Mila

Mila Kostic is Canadian visual artist. After a promising start as an artist in former Yugoslavia, she moved to Vancouver in 1996 with her family. She has worked as a curator, educator, and as facilitator of visual and community based arts, working with diverse artists and organizations representing multiple disciplines. She has been actively exhibiting and making art for over twenty years. Mila has spearheaded many of her own artistic projects and has been associated in particular with promoting

modern art in British Columbia and Canada. Mila is known predominantly for her large - scale abstract acrylic and oil paintings on canvas. Her work revolves around the experimentation with lines and colour; and thematically on the processes of creating a painting.

During the last twenty years of her career, Mila created series entitled "Masks and Dolls", "Writings on the Wall", "Lost states" with diversified themes, and most recently, "The Borders Series" a collection of works focused on the every day; a compound of private, social and political events. These events range from the significant to the mundane, and Mila explores the impact of these events on the individual and seeks to articulate these events into her work through the framing device of the border.

Particularly, through the breaching or crossing of these borders, borders allow some to be on the inside, while forcing others to remain on the outside. This applies not only to territorial borders, but also to borders between identities, genders, ethnicities, classes, sexualities; borders between private and public, between "self" and "other".

Presently, she added a new series of work entitled "Fragments". The "Fragments Series", is a comprised of private, personal and social events in which some may be found to be significant, life - changing, or even hard to shake. Thus, leaving a deep impression, it is natural extension from her early work to the present day.

KWAN Clement 關旭耀

Clement KWAN's figurative paintings are filled with light, color, joy and movement. "I like my paintings to express happiness," Kwan says, "I use my artistic skills to create paintings that will give people joy and hope- my tool for helping to make the world a better place". Born in China, Clement immigrated to Canada in 1979, and now lives in Victoria B.C. Kwan loves draw and paint since his young age. Although he had his basic art training at the

time when he was in china, but most of his artistic knowledge and artistic achievements, is after his move to Canada through decades of dedicated self-education.

Clement likes to combine impressionism with realism in his painting. He has been participating in many art shows in United States and in Canada, and won numerous awards. He is a Senor Signature Member (the highest status) of the Federation of Canadian artists (SFCA), and is a Signature Member of the Oil Painters of America (OPA).

Clement's works can be found in museum, private collections, galleries in United Sates, England, China, and in Canada.

LANG Jun, pen name A Lang. He is of Liao Ling province. Member of Chinese Artists Association. Vice President of the Hong Kong Artists Association, Member of the Liao Ling Writers' Association and Liao Ling Translators' Association. He graduated from Graduate School of Chinese Academy of Arts and studied under the master contemporary Chinese painter, Mr. DU Ziling. His artworks display very solid foundation of artistic skills and training, yet full of innovative ideas and

reality of life. He has gradually developed in his prolonged endeavor his own unique personality in his artworks. He is particularly devoted in portraying the livelihood and sentiment of minority ethnic communities on the highland and plateau region in northern China as well as famous historical characters.

In 2006, awarded honor certificate by the Chinese Collectors Association. Artwork "Battle of the Mountains and Rivers" won award and published in the People's Daily. Artwork "Flying High" also received award from the Chinese Artists Association. Artwork "Vigor and Strength" was presented as national gift to United Nations.

Had hosted numerous exhibitions in many significant arts gallery and museums in Shenzhen, Shantung, Beijing and other big cities, including the more notable "Dancing in the Plateau, Art Exhibition of LANG Jun" in the International Arts Gallery of Vancouver in 2017 and "The Nation of Buddhists, Tour exhibition in Thailand" organized by the Hong Kong Artists' Association in celebration of the Belt and Road Initiative, China 2018.

He also has publication of many art books; and his painting was also selected by China Post in 2014 into commemorative stamp and coin collection for Year of the Horse.

LAW Wayne 羅偉顯

LAW Wai Hin (Wayne), AWS, SFCA - born in 1939, he began painting in 1956. Graduate of the Hong Kong Fine Arts Academy, he studied Western and Chinese painting under NG Po Wan, KWOK Yan Leung, and LEUNG Park Yu. Wayne LAW is a full-time professional artist who also taught watercolors at the Department of Extramural Studies of the Chinese University in Hong Kong, as well as by giving private lessons. From 1976 and continuing until 1990, Wayne exhibited and sold his artwork through his own art gallery in Hong Kong. Wayne has had a numerous one-man and group exhibitions in the Contemporary Hong Kong Art Biennial Exhibitions,

Monte Carlo Art Biennial, Macau Museum, National Art Gallery in Kuala Lumpur in Malaysia, Ayala Museum in Philippines. He also participated in the Asian Watercolour Confederation and exhibited in Korea, Malaysia, Japan, Taiwan, Thailand Macau, Indonesia, and Hong Kong.

Since his immigration to Canada in 1990, Wayne LAW had numerous one-man and group art exhibitions both in Canada and the United States. As well, he has been awarded numerous prizes for his work, some of the more important ones are

Andy Shutse LOU, M.F.A. a renowned artist in Victoria, B.C. was born in China and educated in the United States. Andy adapts a variety of techniques and thoughts from the West, but emphasize his oriental originality. Employing Chinese brushes, rice paper and ink, mixing with watercolour, gouache and acrylic, Andy creates visual statements of the landscapes of North America.

Vibrant colour plays an important role in his art. He blends the old and the new to forge a contrast between ink and colour, between the ancient traditions of Chinese painting and the rapidly-changing world of Western art. Andy's mixed media, cross-cultural paintings have been exhibited and collected worldwide and he has received numerous awards. Andy is also the author of Shi Bai LOU's Art and the co-author of three books on Chinese Brush Painting.

Upon College graduation in Graphic Design and Illustration, he studied and further refined his own unique style, winning top awards in both Canada and USA. His personal favorite is the Master Circle Medallion for the International Association of Pastel Societies, presented in New Mexico in 2013. Xiaoping MENG (Peter), born in the ancient capital of Xi'an, also known as the "ordinary man in the apricot forest", is the former vice president of Richmond Chinese Painting and Calligraphy Club. His is currently the vice president of HanMoFengqi arts group. He has been inspired by art when he was very young, and with a strong passion for Chinese Culture, especially in Chinese painting,

bonsai and carving. The ancient capital has helped him hone his artistic skills, and he was able to create his own unique artistic style. His Chinese painting skill was teached by Professor ZhiGuang ZHANG, of the Xi'an Academy of Fine Arts. Over the years, he has diligently researched and studied artistic theories, and putting them into practice. In 2007 and 2012, his artworks were displayed in Galleries of the Richmond Public Library and Richmond City Hall. A number of media sources interviewed him and published articles of him, and his works was collected by domestic and international art enthusiasts. 





Provide Venue for Exhibition and Event 提供展覽及活動場地



The International Arts Gallery regularly accepts partnership in organizing exhibitions and other events based on the following criteria: a) its artistic value, b) its impact on the community, and c) its recognition by the community. In normal circumstances, the art gallery will invite or consider requests from suitable associations to organise or co-organise exhibitions or events. Terms on co-operation are to be determined in consultation with co-organising bodies.

In relation to applications from other artists and organisations to rent our venue to host exhibitions and events, the following factors will apply:

- a. The event should be in line with our objectives, and the exhibiting parties should meet with our acceptable art standard or condition.
- b. Date of event shall be for seven days, including setting up. The event shall be for one to five persons, or a joint exhibition by an association.
- c. The fee for rental of venue and equipment only shall be ten thousand Canadian dollars (C\$10,000) for 7 days.
- d. A fee of twenty thousand Canadian dollars (C\$20,000) will be charged for the inclusion of invitation letters, posters, advertising, special publication, set up, opening ceremony, tea reception and live demonstration by artists.
- e. Unless special circumstances are justified, the date of event shall be at least three months from the date of application in order to make prearrangements.

These paintings include the ancient, modern and contemporary works of famous Chinese artists, while collectable items include ceramics, jades and jewelry, watches, scholar's objects, soapstones and seals, woodcraft and copper craft, as well as antique furniture.




